



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO DETERMINE THE EXTENT OF TRINITY METALS LTD MINE REHABILITATION LIABILITY, THE DEVELOPMENT OF INTEGRATED AND COSTED MINE CLOSURE AND REHABILITATION PLANS

Trinity Metals Limited was formed in 2022 with the consolidation of three mines: Trinity Nyakabingo Mine (formerly Eurotrade International Ltd), Rutongo Mines Limited and Trinity Musha Mine Ltd (formerly Piran Rwanda Ltd). The consolidation elevated Trinity Metals to its position as a leading mining company and private sector employer in Rwanda.

Trinity Metals Ltd has commissioned updated Environmental and Social Impact Assessments (ESIAs) for each of the Mines. This process, which entails extensive baseline social, cultural and biophysical studies, is programmed for completion in May 2024.

Rehabilitation and Closure Planning and Costing has not been previously undertaken for the three mines.
