1. BACKGROUND

At Rutongo Mines, scrap materials are collected and stored in the scrapyard, where they are sorted in batches/categories. All materials deemed suitable for re-use are identified/marked and separated from those which are to be scrapped, the sorting activity is conducted in coordination with the Engineering, Mining and Supply Chain departments.

Trinity Musha Mines Ltd and Trinity Nyakabingo Mine Ltd, visited the scrapyard and showed no interest in the materials that were deemed scrap at Rutongo. Plastics are separated from metals, and personal protective equipment (PPE) is also sorted and placed aside. In line with company policies and procedures, this document is prepared for the approval process.
