## 1.0 Introduction

Following the email correspondence between SLR Consulting (Africa) (Pty) Ltd (SLR) and Trinity Metals Limited (Trinity Metals) on the 25 June 2025, a proposal has been compiled to undertake the updates/ changes to the Trinity Metals Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA) Reports for the Trinity Musha, Rutongo and Nyakabingo Mines Client's email, to address the additional comments that have been received from the Rwanda Environment Management Authority (REMA) (email dated 19 June 2025).

## 2.0 Background Information

The following REMA changes are requested on 25 June 2025, including the following.

1. The title of the ESIA Reports should be revised to reflect their primary purpose, which is an Environmental and Social Audit. It is recommended to limit the title accordingly to avoid confusion with other assessment types.
2. A detailed and costed rehabilitation plan should be developed and included in the report. This will provide clarity on the financial and logistical requirements for site restoration and ensure accountability throughout the implementation process.
3. The Environmental and Social Management Plan (ESMP) should be integrated into the main report as a dedicated chapter. Additionally, the ESMP must include a clear implementation schedule with defined timelines and identification of responsible institutions or parties for each activity.
