Work Completed Since the Previous Progress Report: During the August 2025 visit to Trinity Metals’ Rwandan operations, OHMS conducted a technical, mine-wide review led by senior geotechnical engineers, combining underground inspections with structured assessments of planning and execution. The work benchmarked rock engineering practice across key domains: integration of geotechnical input into monthly and daily mine planning, the formality and enforcement of workplace “making safe” declarations and barricading, the rigor of fall-of-ground investigations and record-keeping, the adequacy of ground control and legacy timber supports ahead of potential mechanization, and the standardization of blast design (including vibration impacts for Heza/Musha). The team also sanity-checked “future mine” layouts for geotechnical and hydrological risks and evaluated the capacity, structure, and tooling of the geotechnical function. Findings were documented and translated into a consolidated set of governance, design, and implementation recommendations to align the group with industry best practice.
